

The search box



One way is to use the Search Box on the front page.



Type in a word you are looking for information about.




It will show you a list of resources.

Click on the title you want to look at.



This will open a new page so you can see what it is about.

The browse page



Another way to find information is the browse page.

The browse page is good to look at when you want to see what you can find.

Activity Listen Read Watch You can click on the links under the different headings such as

What would you like to do?




To do this click on the link that says Listen or Watch.

A - Z Tags



Another way to see what is in the library is to go to the A - Z tags page.

A tag is like a keyword.

A keyword is a word that describes what the information is about.



The tags are organised in alphabetical order from A - Z.

Sometimes this can be confusing.


