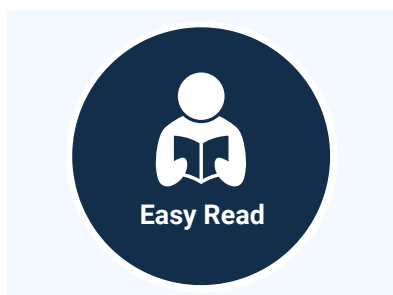

Having chats is a good way to get people to help with your campaign.

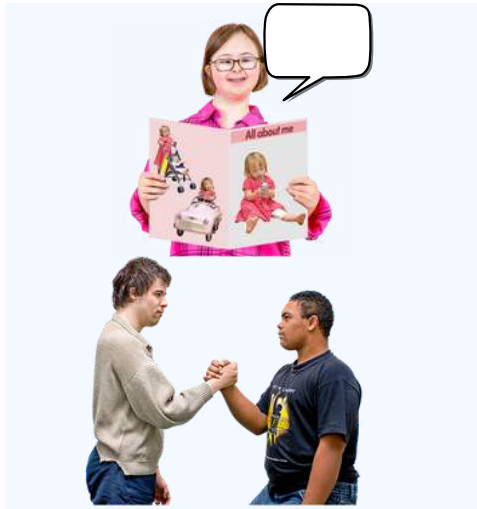

---



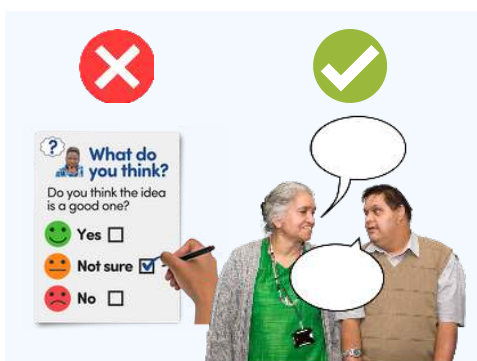
Listen to the other person.

---

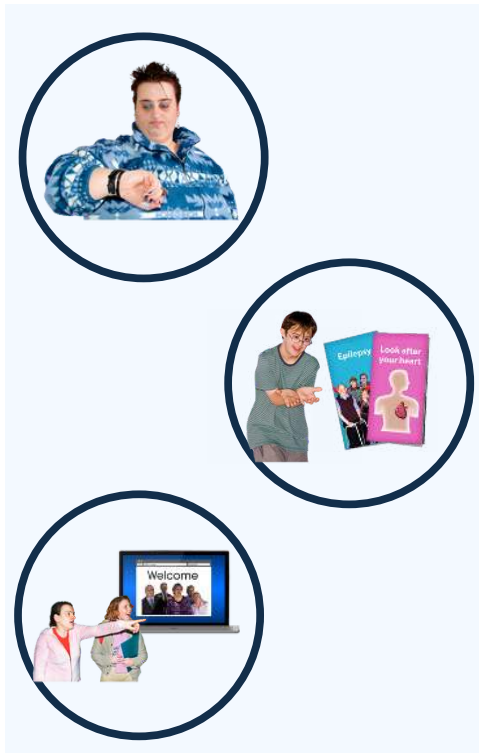


Do not ask yes or no questions.

1. Offer them a brochure.

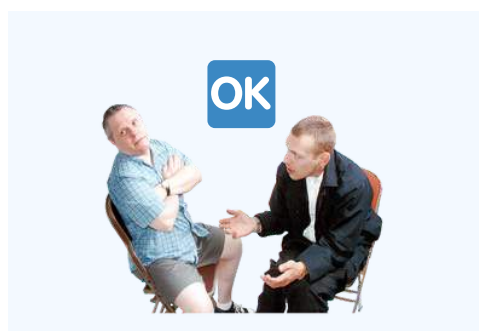
2. Show them your website.

Let them go.

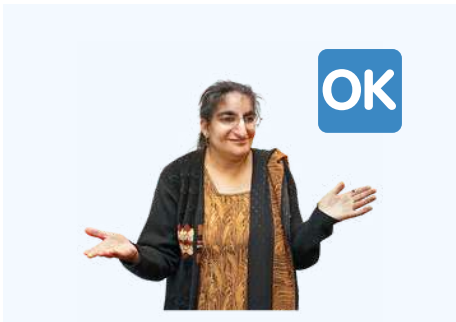

## Important things to remember



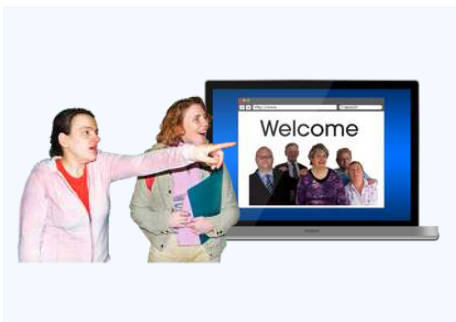
Learn about the topic you will talk about.

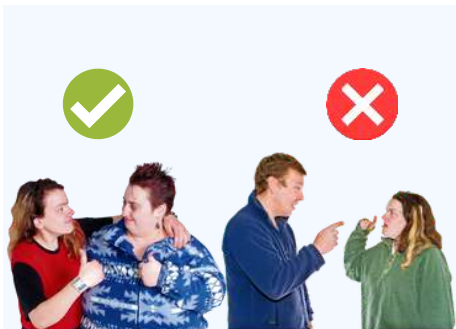

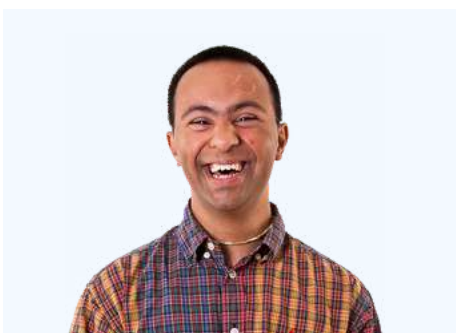
